

Thank you for your interest in the Mooresville Midget Football and Cheerleading Program. The MMFL is made up and run by a Commissioner and volunteers. The MMFL is a proud member of The Big South Youth Football & Cheerleading League. All teams in the BSYFL are located in the surrounding counties. The teams in the BSYFL travel to the area High School football stadiums to play their games. The following is general information of how the league separates the ages of the cheer squads. However, this is determined by the cheer coach and the amount of cheerleaders on each team.

Tiny Mite (ages six (6) and under) Division 1 and Division 2:

Any cheerleader in the Tiny Mites age group shall not attain the age of 7 prior to August 1st of the current playing year.

Mighty Mite (ages eight (8) and under) Division 1 and Division 2:

Any cheerleader in the Mighty Mites age group shall not attain the age of 9 prior to August 1st of the current playing year.

Junior Varsity (ages ten (10) and under) Division 1 and Division 2:

Any cheerleader in the Junior Varsity age group shall not attain the age of 11 prior to August 1st of the current playing year.

Varsity (ages twelve (12) and under) Division 1 and Division 2:

Any cheerleader in the Varsity age group shall not attain the age of 13 prior to August 1st of the current playing year.

PARENTS:

- The MMFL does not require you to work in the stadium at your child's game. However, your child's team may ask for parent volunteer for team specific events and fundraisers.
- Registration fee for cheerleading is \$60 and is <u>NON-REFUNDABLE</u>. This fee will be required at the time of registration. Make checks payable to MMFL.
- You will also be required to purchase the cheer uniform. The cheer coach will provide this information
- ALL cheerleaders wishing to participate in the MMFL program must register during the regular registration period which ends July 31st.
- ALL cheerleader and parents must sign and adhere to the MMFL Discipline Policy.
- Your child's team may ask you to sign and adhere to their individual team policies.
- The MMFL does not supply transportation to or from any practice or game. Arrangements of transportation to and from these activities are the responsibility of the parent or guardian.
- Cheerleaders are expected to attend all practices and games. Multiple unexcused absences will be handled at the discretion of each coach.
- Practice schedules are determined by the coaching staff and will be held at local fields in Mooresville. Parents are responsible for confirming practice field and times. Games are played on Saturday.
- ALL <u>NEW</u> cheerleaders must provide their original birth certificate at the time of certification.

MMFL Football and Cheerleading Discipline Policy

All members will adhere to the following team rules. It is the understanding of the

player/cheerleader/parent/coach that most situations will follow the offense policy that follows. However, it is up to the discretion of the coach and/or league director to review a situation that does not fit neatly into the original rules. Team rules and infraction policies are as follows:

Any of the following actions by any youth participant will result in suspension from a football game(s) and/or practice(s).

- A. Fighting
- B. Malicious foul
- C. Throwing or destroying any league uniform or equipment
- D. Substance abuse
- E. Insubordination

Fighting will automatically suspend a youth from the following week's game. Any youth using profanity during a game will be warned by <u>any</u> coach or commissioner on the first offense, and ejected from the game on the second offense. Any youth found carrying, participating, or under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances will be immediately suspended from any further participation in the league. No tobacco products of any kind are to be allowed on the playing field.

Any youth ejected from a game for any reason must appear on the sideline with his/her coach at the following week's game. It is the responsibility of the team coaches to see that the practice sessions are conducted with the <u>same</u> rules of conducts that govern a game.

If any parent of guardian violates the rules of the organization their child will be suspended indefinitely.

- 1. ATTENDANCE TO PRACTICES IS MANDATORY. If you miss a practice and your coach was not notifies before practice began, it will be at the coach's discretion to take disciplinary action(s).
- 2. TARDINESS FOR GAMES AND PRACTICES IS NOT ACCEPTABLE. Players and cheerleaders are expected to arrive on time for games, practices, and other functions. It is suggested that you plan to arrive five (5) minutes prior to each practice, and one (1) hour prior to each game (depending on each coach's specific rules).
